This document will be available for review during the anonymous judging process. To remain compliant, please do not include any Competitor, team or organization name(s) anywhere in the summary. Summary must be completely anonymous and free from identifying factors.

Font: Calibri, Size: No smaller than 9pt and no larger than 12pt.

- How many hours did you spend crafting your entry?

- What was your experience like creating your entry this year?
- What makes Gingerbread special to you?
- Have you pioneered any new techniques?
